



Arrow valley lake general fishery rules (March 2017)

1. A day permit **must** be purchased before fishing.

This can be obtained in one of two ways:

A) online, by visiting www.arrow-valley.co.uk

Or

B) from the visitor centre at the lake (open 10.00am to 5.00pm daily)

N.b. anglers fishing without a **valid** permit

Will be charged a flat rate fee of £10.00*

(* subject to change)

2. Fishing is allowed in daylight hours only, night fishing is **not** allowed.

3. All anglers **must** be in possession of a current environment agency licence and a functional landing net.

4. Children under 12 yrs of age must be accompanied by a supervising adult.

5. Anglers must ensure their pegs are left completely free of litter

6. Angling on the lake is allowed from clearly designated pegs only

7. Baited hooks must never be left unattended in or out of the water.

8. Barbless hooks **only**.

9. Removal of fish from the lake is **strictly forbidden**. Any person in breach of this rule may face criminal prosecution.

10. Carp should only be retained in keep-nets during properly sanctioned matches, and must be in a separate net to other species.

11. angling methods which utilise floating hookbaits are not permitted on the lake.

12. Anglers are permitted to use a maximum of two rods only.

Persons failing to observe these rules will be asked to leave the lake immediately and may become subject to a permanent ban from fishing on the lake.

Note: Redditch sailing club have the right to exclusive use of the lake as follows: April to September, Sundays between 9am – 1pm. Tuesdays & Thursdays 6pm – 9pm.

October to march, all day Sundays

The fishery management reserves the right to amend these rules at any time. And accepts no responsibility for any injury, loss or damage to persons or property arising directly or indirectly as a result of angling on the lake.
